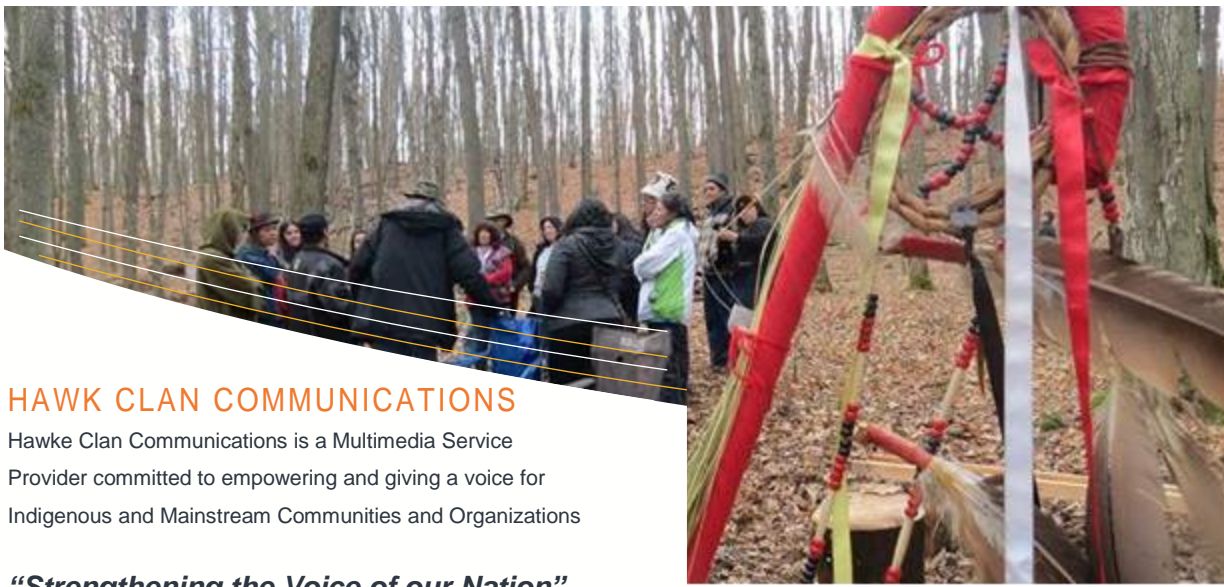

Biiskabiyaang in the Anishinabek Language translates to “We are Coming Back.” This 2 Day Workshop (6 hrs a Day) is ideal for Chief and Councils, Cultural Sensitivity Training, Grade 7-8, Secondary and Post Secondary and Community Organizations and Social Services Working for Aboriginal People and all Canadians. Workshop Includes:

- Ice Breakers, Team Building Skills
 - History of Area and Concepts of our Story
 - Watching Video Documentary on Current First Nations Affairs and Relations with Mainstream
 - Wampum Belts and How Canada Came to Be
 - Colonization and its Effects

Community Mentoring Program

A 5 day Program where each day consists of 6 hours. This is tailored to Social Services (Welfare to Work) where we will engage their Clients in developing a unique Employment Assistance Activity for their Participation Agreement for their Assistance based on our Biiskabiyaang Multimedia Workshops with the intention of creating a network of self-sufficient unity camps getting people off of the Welfare System.

- 2 Days of Biiskabiyaang Multimedia Workshop
- 1 Day of Identifying Clients Skills and Community Strengths. What are Unity Camps and how to Get involved, Developing an Action Plan (Food Security, Jobs) Discussions on obstacles and overcoming them
- 1 Day of Creating a Community Profile Video and preparing for community sharing circle and feast *Most Communities need a platform for its members to voice concerns and have a voice*
- 1 Day Community Sharing Circle and Feast
\$2500 plus Travel and Accommodations and \$1000 for Community Feast
